ZIVEZE CAMPAIGN BEFORE MEMBERSHIP SYSTEM GO-LIVE

The Ziveze campaign is the final step and push to enable members and branches to check and correct their details, before the new Membership system goes live.

The Ziveze campaign calls on ANC members and branches, from **11-13 October 2019** to present themselves (show-up) to check their status at their branch meetings. Youth League members will do so on **10 October**, working with YL BECs and RECs.

Tasks of Branch Secretaries and BECs

- Call a meeting of the BEC immediately to plan for the iZiveze Campaign and meeting of members.
- Invite the ANCYL to the BEC meetings, so they can also prepare for their members to submit their forms on 10 October.
- Make sure you have received the latest Membership list and Preliminary Attendance Register of your branch (from regional office and/through the ANC Cloud).
- Publish the Membership list – on branch Whats App groups, in the PCO offices – so that members can check if their names appear.
- Encourage all members who have not renewed to do so this week, and bring their forms to the BGMs.

- Convene BGMs and/or VD meetings with members to check the Membership lists over the weekend of **11, 12, 13 October**, so the branch can make inputs on the Membership list.
- Keep a report of queries (wrong IDs or names, members who don't appear but should, members past probation period, members who did renew, etc) and submit to the regional office.
- Collect and submit all correction reports, the report of the BGM/VD meetings and outstanding Membership forms to your regional and provincial offices, by not later than **15 October 2019**.

Tasks of ANC Members

- Check with your Branch Secretary, Deputy Secretary and Organiser whether your name appears on the list.
- Go to your branch or VD meeting over the weekend of 12-13 October and encourage other ANC members to come as well.
- Renew your membership if you are not up to date and take your form along to the branch meeting.
- Please indicate if you are also a member of any of the Leagues (Women's, Youth or Veteran's League).

Tasks of Regions and Provinces

- Distribute Membership lists from national to all regions and branches.
- Deploy leadership to branches to help with BGMs and VD meetings over the weekend of **11-13 October 2019** for members to check their membership, and explain the new Membership System.
- Monitor branches and assist those who need assistance, answer queries from members and branches.
- Set up a provincial iZiveze Ops Centre, led by the Provincial Secretary or Deputy Secretary, with Organising, the Membership Officer and interns to help with capturing as forms come in. Each region should also in the regional office set up their iZiveze Ops Centre.
- National will send 2 auditors and 1 national capturer to help the Provincial iZiveze Ops Centres.
- Ensure that all forms submitted by branches are audited and captured on the system, by not later than **17 October 2019**.
- Deal with Problem reports submitted by branches and regions, resolve problems, keep a report of how problems resolved and submit provincial report to national.

Tasks of National Office and Leadership

- Print the latest Membership lists (with all members in the branch: new and on probation, in good standing, not in good standing) and the Preliminary Branch Attendance Regions (only members in good standing) and distribute to provinces and regions, with cover letter from SG.
- SG letter to all structures explaining the process of iZiveze campaign, urging all members to participate.
- Set up iZiveze Operations Centre to respond to queries from structures across the country and assist.
- Deploy 2 Auditors and 1 national capturer per province to the Provincial Ops Centre
- Inform NEC Deployees of iZiveze campaign and the need for them to visit branch general and ward meetings on **11-13 October 2019**.
- NEC Deployees and Officials to visit the Provincial iZiveze Ops centre to check on progress and assist with resolving challenges on **Monday, 14 October 2019**.
- From **14-16 October**, all provinces must convene their Dispute Resolution Committees. These Committees shall deal with all objections during this period. Disputes will be limited to membership issues: exclusion, inclusion, rejection/objections, etc.
- All members and branches who have not corrected by **16 Octo-**

As part of the iZiveze campaign for the new ANC membership system, Youth League members and supporters are also called upon to show up and fill in their membership renewal forms or to bring along someone to join the ANC Youth League.

The **ANC Ziveze campaign** will run from **11-13 October 2019** in all branches, with a special day starting on 10 October for Youth League members.

Tasks of Youth League BECs, RECs and PECs

- Make sure all YL branches have membership forms.
- Encourage YL branches to be

part of ANC Ziveze campaigns Ops centre.

- Have YL information tables with YL membership forms to recruit and renew YL membership.
- Encourage YL members 18 and above to join the ANC.

The ANC Youth League Membership will remain a separate database, in line with the provisions of the autonomy of the League.

The programme is part of the renewal of the ANC and Youth League, coordinated by the ANC Youth League National Youth Task Team and the ANC SGO and Organising.
